The 400 drawing from the tomb of Beni-Hassan, The 219 drawing from the tomb of Bahti III and drawing from the tomb of Sethi, show that wrestling in ancient Egypt was characterized by varied techniques of ground wrestling and rules close to those of contemporary pro-wrestling.
